Please find in the following a check list for your trailers before delivery to avoid repair costs and unnecessary delays.

CHECKLIST

1. Check Doors:

Both doors are properly closed and locked both top and bottom.

2. Check Tarpaulin Cuts/ Holes:

No holes or cuts in the tarpaulin.

3. Check Tarpaulin Rod/Poles:

The tarpaulin bar/rod is closed and locked both top and bottom, on both sides of the trailer.

4. Check Belts:

All belts are in place and are working, closed and locked.

5. Check DGD Labels:

Correct dangerous goods declaration labels are attached on all sides of the trailer.



In order to ensure your lead times, we will coordinate repairs in case of a damaged trailer as soon as possible. Repairs up to 150,00€ are carried out without approval. We will inform you about the type of damage, repair costs and the departure and arrival times, updated where necessary. The repair costs will be directly forwarded to you without additional costs.
