

TT-Line Check-In Information for Passengers

Departure Harbour Rostock

Have your ID and the check-in documents ready (printed out or on your smartphone) and check the [website for up-to-date information](#).

For crossings to Klaipėda or Świnoujście, a passport/ ID scan is mandatory during check-in.

Information for Drivers and Cyclists:

Use our self-check-in machines in the harbour [Zum Fährterminal 1, 18147 Rostock](#).

Attention: Cyclists must wear a safety vest in the harbour!

Check-In Process:

- Check-In opens approx. 2 h before departure and closes 30 min. before departure.
- For departures with “Mecklenburg-Vorpommern” and “Skåne” (Stena Line), it closes 60 min. before departure.

TT-Line Self-Check-In Machines for Drivers and Cyclists:

- Drive to the self-check-in area. Have your booking confirmation and your identification document ready and follow the instructions on the screen.
- The machine will print out your boarding pass. (one p.P.)
- Onward journey: The departure berth and lane are indicated on the boarding card. Follow the signs in the harbour, line up your vehicle and wait for boarding. Follow the instructions of the personnel.

Check-In Process:

- Check-In opens approx. 2 h before departure and closes 30 min. before departure.

- After check-in, wait for the shuttle bus in the designated area of the terminal.

Attention: The same check-in times apply if you have checked in online!
