

TT-Line Check-in Information for Passengers

Departure Harbour Karlshamn

Have your ID and the check-in documents ready (printed out or on your smartphone) and check the [website for up-to-date information](#).

- For trips to Klaipėda and Świnoujście, an ID/passport scan is required.

Information for Drivers, Cyclists and Pedestrians:

Check-in at the terminal [TT-Line AB, Öresundsvägen 49-0 in 37431 Karlshamn \(opening hours\)](#), or at the multi-kiosk in front of the building.

Check-in for departures with the “Optima Seaways” and “Luna Seaways” (DFDS) takes place at the DFDS terminal at the same address.

Attention: Cyclists must wear a safety vest in the harbour!

Check-In Process:

- Check-in opens approx. 2 h before departure and closes 90 min before departure.
- After check-in, pedestrians must wait in the designated area for the shuttle bus, which will pick them up approx. 30 min. before departure.
- After check-in, drivers and cyclists may proceed to the departure berth.

TT-Line Self-Check-In machines for drivers and cyclists:

- Go to the self-check-in area, which is located in front of the TT-Line terminal.
- Have your booking confirmation and ID document ready.
- Follow the on-screen instructions.
- The machine will print out a boarding pass for each passenger.
- Entering the harbour: Select TT-LINE on the screen of the barrier and scan the barcode on the boarding pass to open the barrier.
- Onward journey: The departure berth and lane are indicated on the boarding card. Follow the signs in the harbour, line up your vehicle and wait for boarding. Follow the instructions of the personnel.

Attention: The same check-in times apply if you have checked in online beforehand!
